ORDER EXTENDING APPOINTMENT
OF COURT LIAISON OFFICER

UPON THE MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, by and through its attorneys, Michael A. Battle, United States Attorney for the Western District of New York, and Bruce G. Orr, Chief, Organized Crime and Racketeering Section, United States Department of Justice, and Laborers' Local 210, by and through William Hoffman, Business Manager for Laborers' Local 210, and upon the Affidavit of Charles B. Wydysh, Assistant United States Attorney, dated January 21, 2005, in support of the motion for an order by this Court extending the appointment of John J. McDonnell, Liaison Officer, Laborer's Local 210, to January 24, 2006; and

IT APPEARING that the motion has been made in good faith and is fully supported by the facts alleged in the Affidavit submitted in support thereof; now

THIS COURT FINDS that pursuant to the stipulation and order of this Court as to the appointment of a Court Liaison Officer, dated January 24, 2000, and ¶ 5(L) of the Consent Decree among the parties, dated December 8, 1999, and ordered by this Court on January 24, 2000, good cause has been shown to extend the length of the Court Liaison Officer's term to January 24, 2006 in order to allow the Court Liaison Officer to continue and complete matters initiated before termination of his term; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the term of John J. McDonnell, Court Appointed Liaison Officer for Laborers' Local 210, be extended to January 24, 2006.
