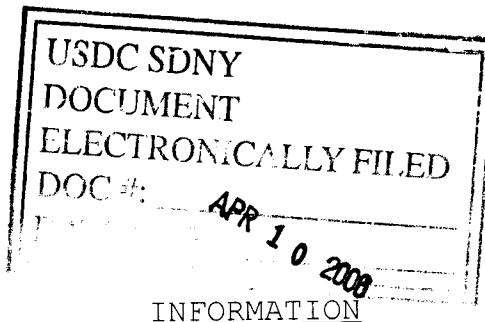

S5 04 Cr. 343 (KMW)

COUNT ONE

The United States Attorney charges:

1. In or about 1997, in the Southern District of New York and elsewhere, ROBERT CARBONE, a/k/a "Bucky," the defendant, and others known and unknown, through CARBONE's membership in the Genovese Organized Crime Family, unlawfully, willfully, and knowingly combined, conspired, confederated, and agreed together and with each other to commit extortion, as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(b)(2), by obtaining money and property from and with the consent of another person, to wit, the officers and membership of Local 530 of the Operative Plasters and Cement Masons Union, which consent would have been, and was, induced by the wrongful use of actual and threatened force, violence and fear, and thereby would and did obstruct, delay and affect commerce, and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, as that term is defined in Title 18,

United States Code, Section 1951(b)(3), to wit, CARBONE agreed to use fear of economic harm to force officers of Local 530 to pay a portion of the officers' salary to CARBONE.
